Advocacy

- ✔ Are you receiving Commonwealth-funded aged care services?
- ✔ Having challenges with an aged care service provider and not being heard?
- ✔ Do you need help working out the aged care system?

An Advocate is an independent and impartial person who can help you speak for yourself, or speak on your behalf.

Advocates can assist by:

- Empowering you with up-to-date information on your aged care rights
- Supporting you to understand the aged care system
- Helping to achieve a resolution on an issue with your provider.

WA Elder Abuse Helpline

- ✔ Are you concerned you or someone you know is experiencing some form of elder abuse?
- ✔ Do you know what steps to take to safeguard yourself or support others?

The WA Elder Abuse Helpline is a free and confidential phone information service for people to seek initial support about elder abuse.

Advocates can provide information to assist with identifying elder abuse and then chat through some options you may feel comfortable exploring.

Please note, this is not a reporting line. The older person has the right and option to take any action, such as reporting it to the police.

- Are reluctant to engage with aged care or government.

Home Care Check-in Service

- ✔ Do you have concerns about a vulnerable older person who's living at home alone?

This service is for older people who may be experiencing one or more of these factors:

- Experiencing grief or loss
- Do not have family or friends that regularly check on them
- Struggle communicating
- Have mobility issues
- Lost the ability to drive.

Our Community Support Advocates provide regular 'check-ins' and can help with organising extra support. If you know an older person and have concerns about their welfare, please contact our advocates on 1800 655 566.

The service operates in the Perth metropolitan area and the South West, but is by referral only, such as from a service provider or the Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT).
